

PARKING AT UMD Subject to Change

Commuters (those staying off campus):

Commuters and spectators may pre-purchase daily permits at https://umd.aceparking.com beginning Thursday, May 16, at 9:00 a.m. ET. You are encouraged to purchase and print your parking passes at home prior to arrival.

The Department of Transportation's (DOTS) office in <u>Regents Drive Garage</u> will have terminals where guests can print permits that have been purchased using the https://umd.aceparking.com website if you were unable to do so prior to your arrival on campus. The DOTS office is open during business hours, from 8:15 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday- Friday.

Residents (those staying in the campus dorms):

Residence hall guests are entitled to ONE guest parking permit and may request it when they check into campus housing. Resident permits are valid in lots 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 9, 11, 16, and 19. Please carefully read parking lot signs and do not park in any lot beginning with a letter (staff lots). Housing check-in is available in the Stamp Student Union's Colony Ballroom during these hours: Saturday, June 8, 2:00 - 8:00 p.m. and Sunday, June 9, 9:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.; Housing check-in moves to the alcove outside of the Prince George's Room (Stamp Student Union) on Monday, June 10, 8:00 - 11:00 a.m. Those arriving outside of these hours may check in at LaPlata Hall, 8160 Farm Dr, College Park, MD 20742

Registration Parking

The Union Lane Garage will offer free <u>temporary</u> parking on Saturday, June 8, and Sunday, June 9. Free Sat/Sun parking is in lots 1 and Z, west of Stamp Student Union.

**Please note that the total parking capacity available for sale has been reduced due to campus construction. It is strongly recommended that parking permits be purchased online before registration. Permits may be sold out by the start of on-campus registration. Permits can be bought at https://umd.aceparking.com. Residence hall guests checking in on Monday after 11:00 a.m. will receive their permits at the residence hall at check-in. Registration on Saturday and Sunday in the Stamp Student Union's Colony Ballroom will have a terminal for guests to print permits that have been purchased using the https://umd.aceparking.com website.

Oversized Vehicle Parking

Participating guests who are using rental moving trucks, trailers, or any other large vehicle that does not fit into a single 8' x 18' parking space must purchase an oversized vehicle permit at https://umd.aceparking.com. All oversized vehicles and trailers must have a permit and park in **lot 1c**. Lot 1c will have two sections: one for normal-sized vehicles (\$15/day) and one section for oversized vehicles and trailers (\$25/day). Permits are required Monday-Thursday, 7:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Closing Awards Ceremony

Commuters and spectators attending the closing ceremony on Thursday, June 13 who have pre-purchased their permits, may park in lots 4b, 6(TTG), and 11b. You MUST have a prepaid permit to park in these lots. There will not be on-site sales for parking permits at the Xfinity center for the 2024 Awards Ceremony. Limited metered parking is available at the Xfinity Visitor Lot (XVL) on a first-come, first-served basis. Campus meter rates are \$3/hr. Judge parking placards are NOT valid for the Closing Awards Ceremony. Spectators are also welcome to park in their valid permit lots and ride the free shuttle service to the Xfinity Center.
